## UTAH'S BEST DANCE PARTY

Every January, Park City, Utah, marvels as 20,000 Angelenos and New Yorkers flock to Robert Redford's Sundance Film Festival at the height of ski season . . . and watch movies. The locals have a different idea of what to do in the Wasatch Range in winter. Hence the X-Dance Action Sports Film Festival (January 18–22; [x-dance.com](http://x-dance.com)), the latest in a string of spoofs on Sundance (Slamdance, TromaDance, Nodance). The three-year-old X-Dance — the brain-child of actor Brian Wimmer, who worked in Redford's stables as a kid — takes place in a nightclub and showcases ski, skate, surf, bike, and board films. Of course, it's also an excuse for a party. And what a party it is: The past two, which featured DJ Paul Oakenfold and headbangers P.O.D., among others, went all night and eclipsed even the studio-sponsored Sundance fetes. —BILL KERIG
